This will include floor plans, elevations and sections.

On finalisation of the design, you will produce plumbing and electrical drawing and fitting packs for the installation teams working on site.

Using established Kitchen Architecture design principles, critical to the meticulous standards our brand demands, you will be expected to work on a variety of projects.

You may also be involved with company marketing and PR. This will include: maintaining our extensive photo library; sourcing, updating and creating content for Kitchen Architecture's website, bulthaup's website, and our digital/social media channels. You will analyse tracking and digital data (including our CRM – Zoho) to understand trends, evaluate campaigns and support better marketing decisions; as well as helping with events, CRM maintenance, and other adhoc activities.
